

**OREGON TROMBONIST HENRY HENNIGER IS GUEST
SOLOIST WITH VANCOUVER SYMPHONY NOV 12 & 13**

Concert to include La Scala di Seta and Prokofiev 5

(Vancouver, WA) With the approach of Thanksgiving comes **The Vancouver Symphony Orchestra's** second concert of the season on November 12 & 13, 2011, highlighted by acclaimed Oregon trombone soloist Henry Henniger, playing *Concertino for Trombone* No. 4, Op. 4 by Ferdinand David. Salvador Brotons conducts.

Each concert begins with the overture to *La Scala di Seta* by Rossini and is followed by Mr. Henniger's appearance. The concert concludes with the grand and patriotic *Symphony No. 5* by Prokofiev.

Henry Henniger, a native Oregonian, joined the University of Oregon faculty in 2010. Previously, he taught at Oregon State University and Linfield College. Active nationally as a soloist and orchestral musician, He has performed frequently with the Eugene Symphony, Sun River Music Festival, Spokane Symphony, Astoria Music Festival, Oregon Bach Festival, Oregon Symphony and the Seattle Symphony. Henry is principal trombone of the Portland Opera and Oregon Ballet Theatre and is also a member of the Oregon Brass Quintet.
